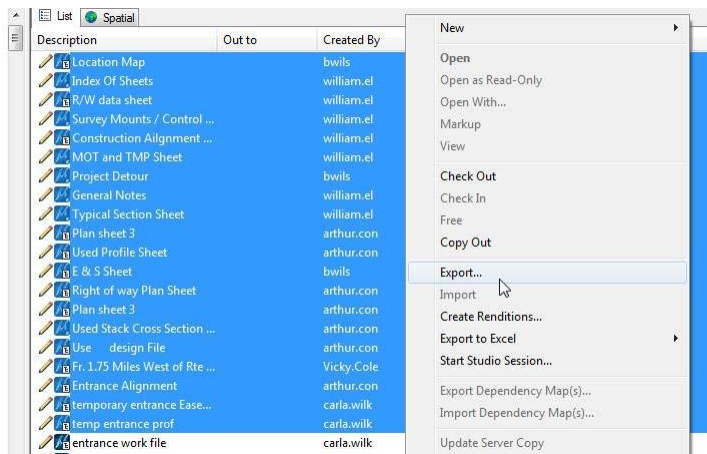


ProjectWise – Revising Multiple CADD Files

If CADD drawings are being revised outside of ProjectWise (**NOT RECOMMENDED**), there is a proper procedure for updating the files. Deleting all the files and re-adding those files breaks the reference links and causes issues. Using the Export/Import tool in ProjectWise will prevent those links from being broken.

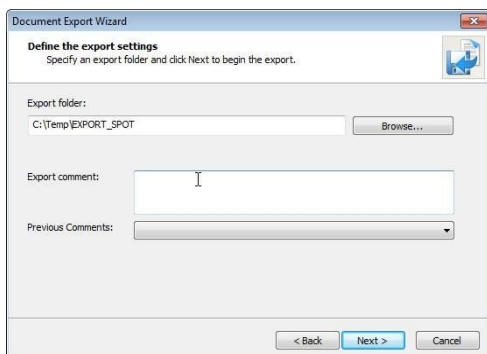
Select the files that will be revised.



Right click and select 'Export' – the window below will appear

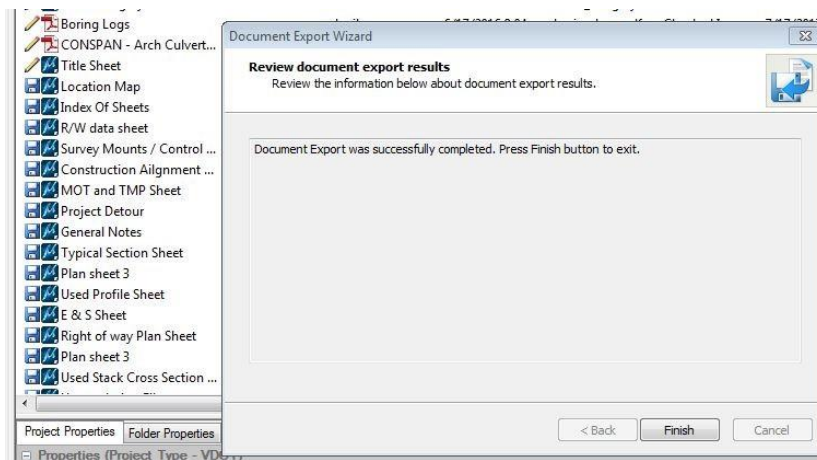


Choose the top radio button, **Export** (so you can reimport) then the *Next* button. The screen below will appear. This is the export location selected by you so the files can be easily located for update.

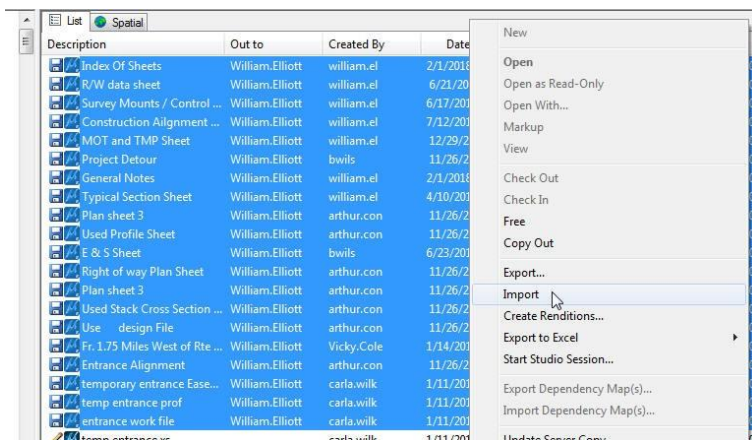


ProjectWise – Revising Multiple CADD Files

Click *Next* and the files are exported. Notice the “Floppy Disk” icon on the image below. Those files are ready to be updated. They’re exported onto your computer. Click *Finish*.

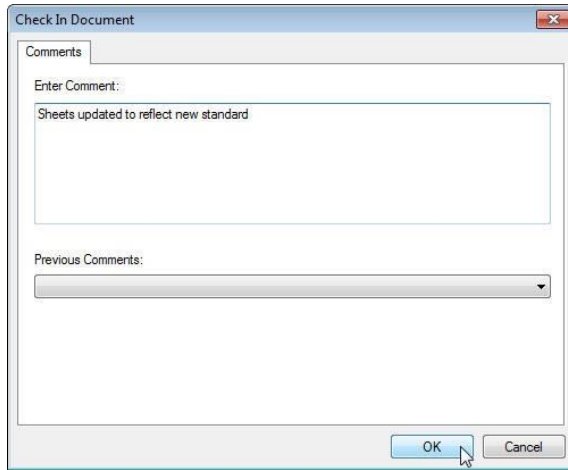


The next step is to copy the files from your computer and update the ones at the export location you chose. Please note the file name must be an exact match to update. Go back to ProjectWise, highlight the files, right click and *Import*.
